Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter *Desiderio Desideravi* (2022) on Liturgical Formation of the People of God invites renewed reflection on the preparation and celebration of the Church's liturgy. WORKSHOP 1. FOR MINISTERS OF THE WORD In this workshop Dr Chris Cotter, Director of the Diocesan Mission and Pastoral Life Office will explore the scripture readings for Year C. Drawing upon relevant guidance in Pope Francis' letter and other resources, Chris will work with current and prospective Ministers of the Word and suggest ways they might help bring the Word alive through their liturgical ministry in their local communities.

WORKSHOP 2. FOR EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION In this workshop Lyn Breen, formerly Faith Formation Coordinator for the Diocese of Sandhurst, will explore the implications in *Desiderio Desideravi* for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion within Mass, taking into account diocesan guidelines regarding the Ministry of Communion Under Both Kinds.

WORKSHOP 3. FOR LITURGICAL MUSICIANS In this workshop Paul Taylor, Assistant Director of the ACU Centre for Liturgy and Director of Music at Sacred Heart Cathedral in Bendigo, will work the liturgical musicians in drawing forth implications from *Desideravi* for the art of liturgical music ministry, particularly for keyboard players and Cantors/leaders of song.
