Act of Consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Immaculate Heart of Mary, Queen of Heaven and Earth, and tender mother to us all.

I consecrate to you myself and all members of the human race, and in particular, my country and my family.

Reign over us and teach us how to make the heart of Jesus reign and triumph in us and around us, as it has reigned and triumphed in You.

Reign over us dearest mother, that we may be yours in prosperity and adversity, in joy and sorrow, in health and sickness, in life and death.

Most Compassionate Heart of Mary, Queen of Virgins, watch over our minds and hearts and preserve them from the deluge of impurity, which is so universal today, of which you lamented so sorrowfully to the seers of Fatima. We want to be pure like you. We want to atone for the many crimes committed against Jesus and against you. We want to call down upon our country, and the whole world the peace of God in justice and in charity.

Therefore we now promise to imitate your virtues by the practice of a Christian life without regard to human respect.

We resolve to fulfill your requests at Fatima to do penances and reparation and on the first Saturday of the month to offer up our confessions, communions and rosaries as an act of reparation to help bring about the triumph of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, the salvation of souls, the overcoming of the evils of communism and the establishment of peace for the Church and the world under the reign of your Immaculate Heart.

The Peace Plan from Heaven

My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God.

Our Lady promised: "If my requests are heard, Russia will be converted and there will be peace."

Another promise of Our Lady of Fatima concerns the first Saturdays:

"I promise to help at the hour of death, with the graces needed for salvation whoever on the 1st Saturday of five consecutive months shall:

- Confess and receive Holy Communion
- Recite five decades of the Rosary
- Keep me company for 15 minutes, meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary,
- with the intention of making reparation to me
- and wear the scapular and offer reparation through sacrifices demanded by your daily duty."

By the infinite merits of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg the conversion of poor sinners.

Eucharistic Prayer

Most Holy Trinity, I adore you! My God, My God, I love you in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

Pardon Prayer

I believe, I adore, I trust and I love Thee! I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not trust and do not love Thee.

Sacrifice Prayer

O my Jesus, it is for love of you, in reparation for offences committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and for the conversion of poor sinners.
