If you feel called to be part of this once-in-a-lifetime journey of faith, community, and encounter and are between the ages of 18 and 35, we invite you to take the first step! Estimated cost is between \$6,200 and \$8,500. After subsidies, the estimated cost to individual pilgrims will be \$2000 - \$3000. Final cost is dependent on multiple factors.
